Our **FEES**

SailTime Joining Fee - £1750 inc VAT

This is a one off joining fee which includes a 2-day one to one induction, and a contribution towards general wear and tear for the life time of your membership. The joining fee also gives you access to SailTime bases world wide. Payment is due at the start of your membership.
